

In this Privacy Information Sheet, we would like to provide you with an overview of how we process your personal data and what your rights are under data protection law. The scope and nature of processing are governed by the individual purpose resulting from the contractual relationship between us. Because of this individuality, not all parts of this Data Protection Information Sheet will apply to you.

1. What are personal data?

Personal data are all information relating to you as an identified or identifiable individual. Customer data are a part of this, as are personal data such as the personnel file of employees. For instance, the name of a contact allows for inferences concerning an individual, as does his E-mail address. It is sufficient that the relevant information is connected to your name or, irrespective of this, can be derived from the context. A person is similarly identifiable if the information must first be connected to what is additionally known such as in the case of a car license plate number. How the information is created is irrelevant for the connection to a person. Photographs, videos or audio recordings can constitute personal data.

2. Who is the processor and who is my contact?

3. How are data collected and what data are collected?

We process the personal data we have received from you over the course of making performance under the contractual relationships in place between us. Provided this is necessary to make performance under our contractual relationship, we will also process your personal data we obtain from publicly accessible sources (e.g. commercial register, Internet). Thus, personal information (name, address and other contact details) and all data required to process a contract such as information on the means of payment or the billing address are collected and processed.

4. What is the purpose of processing and on which legal basis are data processed?

We only process your data if the legal ground for this is stated in the GDPR. Possible scenarios are: We process your data pursuant to Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 a GDPR on the basis of your express consent or under Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 b GDPR to fulfill contractually defined purposes or under Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 c GDPR if there is a legal duty to do so or under Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 f GDPR to assert, exercise or defend legal claims if there is no ground to assume that you have an overriding legitimate interest in the nondisclosure of your data. Please note that you may revoke a granted consent at any time with effect for the future.

5. To whom are the data disclosed?

In a business, those parties obtain access to your data who need them to perform our contractual and legal obligations. A transmission of your personal data to third parties for purposes other than those listed below does not occur. We only share your personal data with a third party if: (1) you have given your express consent to this under Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 a GDPR, (2) the disclosure is required under Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 f GDPR to assert, exercise or defend legal claims and there is no ground to assume that you have an overriding legitimate interest in the nondisclosure of your data, (3) in the event that there is a legal duty to disclose them under Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 c GDPR, and (4) to the extent this is permitted under law and Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 b GDPR for the settlement of the contract. In this last case, the service providers and agents with whom we have entered into processor agreements will also receive your data from us to the extent this is required.

6. Will data be transmitted to a third country (outside of the European Union)?

The transmission of your data to parties in countries outside of the European Union should not occur as a general rule. As an exception, a transmission will occur if this is absolutely necessary to make performance under the contract (e.g. assignments in foreign countries or use of foreign services), or it is provided for under law (e.g. for tax obligations) or you have given your consent.

7. For how long are the data stored?

We delete the accrued data after their storage for the performance of contractual and legal duties, including, but not limited to, statutory retention duties is no longer necessary.

8. Are fully automated decision-making processes or so-called profiling used?

We do not use any such procedures.

9. What duties do I have as the data subject?

You must provide the personal data for the contractual relationship between us which are needed to begin, execute and terminate the contractual relationship and to perform the contractual and statutory duties associated with it.

10. What are my privacy rights?

Under the GDPR you have the following rights in relation to us concerning your personal data:

(1) the right to information, (2) the right to correction and deletion, (3) the right to a limitation of processing, (4) the right to object to processing, (5) the right to data portability, and, additionally, you have (6) the right to lodge a complaint against our processing of your personal data at the data protection supervisory agency. The limitations of Sections 34 and 35 Federal Data Protection Act apply for the right to information and the right to deletion.

11. Do I have a right to object?

If your personal data is processed on the basis of a legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 f GDPR or the performance of a duty which is in the public interest pursuant to Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 e GDPR, you have the right under Art. 21 GDPR to lodge an objection against the processing of your personal data, provided the grounds provided there are grounds arising from your special situation or the objection is concerned with direct advertising.
